### **SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTARY AND MEDICAL EVIDENCE**

I enclose a copy of a 48-page medical and family case-history – *Special Operations in Medical Research* – in which is revealed evidence and allegations relating to a serious medical assault upon myself at age six (in 1967), by surgeons at the North Staffs Infirmary, under the fraudulent guise of a routine 'tonsillectomy' operation, and involving the implantation of a series of surreptitious cranial devices. In addition the report also reveals evidence which supports the allegation that my father was murdered by medical professionals, in 1968, as a consequence of his discovery of the fact of this operation.

An earlier version of this report has existed since 2003, when it was submitted to the GMC, as well as to the Metropolitan and Staffordshire Police forces. However, in the absence of *prima facie* evidence, the police did not act at that time. Such *prima facie* evidence now exists in the form of a Brain MRI scan, made on 02/10/2008 at St. Thomas' Hospital. I also enclose a copy of the MRI scan, plus scan of the original disc-face.

As far as I am aware, there has been as yet no formal corroboration of this from the medical profession; that is in spite of my having received a consultation over the scan from a neurologist (Dr. Thomasin Andrews) at Guy's Hospital in 2009. Probable reasons for this reticence are suggested in the Postscript of the above report. My understanding is that the MRI evidence is clear and distinct, particularly with reference to the 26-image sequence comprising 'Series 7' of the scan, and essentially confirms all of the allegations made in my report regarding events in 1967-68.

I have recently re-submitted the report, together with copies of the MRI scan to both police forces, but have not yet received anything in response from them. The matter has also been presented to the IPCC, in the context of my complaint over the police's failure to respond appropriately to my reports to them of a series of threats to my life; and to my local MP Kate Hoey. Regrettably, neither the police, the IPCC, nor my MP (nor, for that matter, any

member of the medical or legal professions) have found it possible to openly acknowledge or discuss the details of this evidence, implicating as it does a serious State and NHS (and corporate) criminal conspiracy.
